Visit **Diver City**, or during seasonal departures (Mar 22 – Apr 5 / Oct 18 – Nov 8), enjoy **cherry blossom viewing at Ueno Park** or **autumn maple leaves at Yoyogi Park** instead of the Gundam Base. Conclude with **Sensoji Temple** and **Nakamise-dori Street**, where shops offer traditional crafts and local snacks.

Day 4 | Mount Fuji - Majesty and Tranquility

Travel to **Yamanashi** and explore the wonders around **Mount Fuji**. Begin at the **Mount Fuji Earthquake Experience Museum**, gaining insight into Japan's seismic history, then feel the excitement at the **Mount Fuji Earthquake Simulator Center**. Discover **Yoshida Sky Ladder Town**, where charming streets lead to stunning mountain views. Enjoy a **scenic cruise on Lake Yamanaka**, mirroring the grandeur of Mount Fuji.

Day 5 | Kyoto & Osaka - Golden Temples and Spiritual Elegance

Step into Kyoto and Osaka's cultural heritage. Visit **Kinkakuji (Golden Pavilion)**, a gleaming temple mirrored in its tranquil pond. Explore the serene **Heian Shrine**, a testament to classical Japanese architecture. Wander through **Fushimi Inari Taisha**, famed for its thousands of vermilion torii gates, or during seasonal departures, enjoy **cherry blossom viewing at Maruyama Park** (Mar 22 – Apr 5) or **autumn maple leaves at Lanshan Ferry Moon Bridge** (Oct 18 – Nov 8).

Day 6 | Nara & Osaka - Gentle Deer and Urban Wonders

After breakfast, visit **Nara Park** and meet the gentle, free-roaming deer. Explore **Todaiji Temple**, a UNESCO World Heritage site housing the Great Buddha. Stroll through **Osaka Castle Park** (without climbing), and experience the vibrant energy of **Shinsaibashi-suji Shopping Street**. Conclude the day at **Dotonbori**, where canals reflect dazzling lights and the aroma of local delicacies fills the air.
