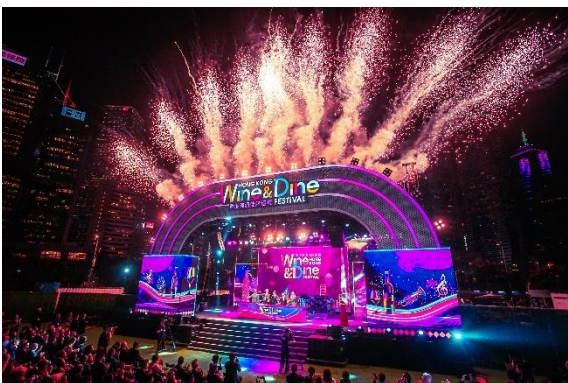

Itinerary

Day 1 | 24 Oct: Depart from Canada

Your unforgettable journey begins as you board your international flight from Calgary to Hong Kong via Vancouver. Let the anticipation build as you cross the Pacific toward a land where ancient traditions meet modern wonders.

Day 2 | 25 Oct: Across the Pacific

Spend the day in flight as the world slowly shifts beneath you. Rest, dream, and let the excitement build as you draw closer to the lights, mountains, coastlines, and stories of Southern China.

Day 3 | 26 Oct: Arrival in Hong Kong & Into the Future of Shenzhen

Arrive in Hong Kong and continue by cross-border coach into Shenzhen, one of the Mainland China's most dynamic cities of innovation. Here, the future feels close enough to touch. Visit the futuristic **Robot 6S Store**, then stroll through **Lianhuashan Park**, where everyday life meets tomorrow's technology, including drone delivery in action.

As evening falls, settle into Shenzhen and enjoy your first taste of the city's bold, energetic cuisine.

Day 4 | 27 Oct: Zhongshan Heritage & Coastal Zhuhai

After breakfast, journey to Zhongshan, birthplace of Dr. Sun Yat-sen, where his preserved former residence offers a meaningful glimpse into modern Mainland China's revolutionary history. Continue onward to Zhuhai, a graceful coastal city where palm-lined boulevards meet the South China Sea.

Visit the ornate **Meixi Memorial Archways**, stroll along **Lovers' Road** beside the iconic **Fisher Girl Statue**, and admire the elegant shell-shaped **Zhuhai Opera House** rising from the waterfront like twin moons above the sea.

Day 5 | 28 Oct: A Day in Macau's Old World Charm

Cross through the **Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macau Bridge** port and step into Macau, a city where East and West have shared the same streets for centuries. Pastel facades, stone squares, incense-filled temples, and grand resorts all tell different chapters of the same story.

Stand before the **Ruins of St. Paul's**, wander through **Senado Square**, visit **St. Dominic's Church**, and pause at **A-Ma Temple**, where Macau's maritime spirit still lingers. Later, experience the dazzling atmosphere of The **Venetian Macau** before returning to Zhuhai.

Day 6 | 29 Oct: Living History in Jiangmen

Travel to Jiangmen, the cherished homeland of many overseas Chinese families. In **Chikan Ancient Town**, arcaded streets and riverside scenes recall another era, while **Zili Village's Diaolou watchtowers** stand as proud symbols of resilience, family, and connection across oceans.

Later, visit **Xinhui Chenpi Village**, where aged tangerine peel carries the fragrance of time itself, treasured in Cantonese cooking and wellness traditions.

Lunch: Chinese hometown cuisine, including eel rice

Dinner: Xinhui Tangerine Peel Banquet

Day 7 | 30 Oct: Water Villages & Mountain Horizons

This morning, enter Shunde, a place revered as one of the great homes of Cantonese cuisine. Wander through **Qinghui Garden**, where pavilions, water, stone, and greenery create a refined Lingnan elegance. Then visit **Fengjian Water Village**, where bridges curve over quiet canals and time seems to soften.

Continue to Zhaoqing and explore **Seven Star Crag**, a landscape of limestone peaks, clear waters, and poetic mountain reflections.

Lunch: Shunde cuisine

Dinner: Traditional Zhaoqing rice dumpling delicacy

Day 8 | 31 Oct: Serenity of Dinghu Mountain

Today is a day for slower breath and deeper stillness. Visit **Dinghu Mountain**, one of Southern China's treasured natural sanctuaries. At **Baoding Garden** and **Qingyun Temple**, forest paths, temple bells, and mountain air create a peaceful retreat from the rush of the world.

Later, walk along the **Song Dynasty Ancient City Wall** and discover **Duan Inkstone Cultural Village**, where the artistry of scholars has been preserved through generations.

Lunch: Dinghu vegetarian cuisine

Dinner: Xijiang River Fresh banquet

Day 9 | 1 Nov: Return to Hong Kong + Wine & Dine Celebration

Travel back toward Hong Kong via the Shenzhen border. Upon arrival, settle into your hotel and rest before an unforgettable evening at the **Hong Kong Wine & Dine Festival**.

As **Victoria Harbour** glows beneath the night sky, raise a glass amid gourmet flavours, global wines, live energy, and the sparkling skyline. It is a celebration of Hong Kong at its most vibrant: elegant, generous, and full of life.

Lunch: Shenzhen Hakka cuisine

Dinner: Hong Kong Wine & Dine Festival (with premium wine tasting pass)

Day 10 | 2 Nov: Lantau Island Serenity

Leave the bustle of the city behind and journey to Lantau Island. Glide above green mountains on the **Ngong Ping 360 Cable Car**, with sweeping views opening beneath you. At **Ngong Ping Village**, **Po Lin Monastery**, and the majestic **Tian Tan Buddha**, the day takes on a quieter, more reflective spirit.

Here, incense drifts through the mountain air, and the great bronze Buddha watches peacefully over the island.

Lunch: Po Lin Monastery Vegetarian banquet

Dinner: Hong Kong local cuisine

Day 11 | 3 Nov: Skylines and Street Scenes

Ride the **Peak Tram** to **Victoria Peak** and look out over one of the world's most unforgettable skylines. Continue through the city's landmark scenes, from the **Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre** and **Golden Bauhinia Square** to the renewed **Central Market**.

Later, stroll along the **Avenue of Stars** in Tsim Sha Tsui, where the harbour lights shimmer across the water. On this final evening, share a Hong Kong seafood banquet and savour the feeling of a journey beautifully completed.

Day 12 | 4 Nov: Farewell Hong Kong

After breakfast, transfer to **Hong Kong International Airport** or continue your own journey independently.
